The blessing will take place at the beginning of the service. Please keep dogs on leashes and other small animals in carriers.

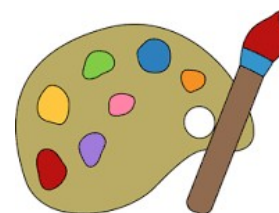
Missing a jacket? Please check your closets. Jackets left in the narthex will be collected for the outreach van on September 21.
